Policy Title:	Physical Fitness Stipends – Non Union Jail & HOC Officers

POLICY

To promote staff health and fitness to ensure their capability to perform all functions of the job, non-union jail and HOC officers are eligible to receive an annual physical fitness stipend.

PROCEDURE

Officers in non-union positions at Carroll County House of Corrections (CCHOC) are annually eligible to receive a physical fitness stipend.

To be eligible, the employee:

- Must complete one year of employment with CCHOC
- Present a valid physician's clearance to participate in physical fitness testing
- Participate in the Cooper Standards physical fitness testing. (Testing offered annually at the facility)
- Complete the fitness testing regimen required in NHAC Chapter 300A:5 for his/her age and gender.

Upon successful completion of the above-mentioned criteria, the employee will receive a stipend check in an amount set by the Carroll County Board of Commissioners. Payment will be made through the payroll system and is subject to applicable taxes.
